Understanding the Legal and Business Context for Road Transport Operations. It is recommended that you spend 25 hours of study preparing for unit one.

In addition to the taught hours, you will need to spend sufficient time studying independently. The study plan prepared by your learning provider will show what you will need to learn, and how long you should spend on this work.

You will need to learn, understand and be able to apply various principles of the law to the general business operation, including aspects of:

- É How businesses do business with each other (Contract law)
- É What type of legal organisation a business can be
- É How companies and individuals are taxed
- É Who protects employees (Trade Unions)
- É Running a safe business
- É The rights of employees and employers
- É How the Working Time Directive can affect the workforce
- É How a business is financed
- É What the figures on the final accounts mean . profit & loss, balance sheet etc.
- É How the figures on the final accounts can tell whether the business is financially sound or not
- É How to market the business, and keep effective records
- É Consider the environment
- É What to do to continue with %Business as usual+if an emergency occurs.

Exam will include 30 multiple choice questions . you need at least 70% correct to pass.
